COUNSELING PROCESS

While working together, I will attempt to create an open, warm environment where you feel comfortable in sharing with me. We will discuss concerns that you are currently experiencing, as well as, some of the historical, cultural, and societal factors that may be involved. When appropriate, agreed-upon goals may be set, and evaluation of the effectiveness of those goals will be undertaken.

SERVICES PROVIDED

My areas of competence include adolescent counseling; individual counseling; career counseling; grief and loss issues; anxiety issues; gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender issues; and consultation. If our work together leads to problems beyond my expertise, I will help you obtain the necessary services from the appropriate specialist. My style is very much solution-focused, and theoretically, I am committed to the enhancement of the whole person using a combination of humanistic, cognitive-behavioral, and systems-based therapeutic approaches.

EXPECTATIONS AND/OR ANTICIPATED RESULTS; POSSIBLE RISKS

My expectations of our counseling relationship include consistent attendance, the willingness to explore, to show commitment to the process, and honesty. We will discuss the expectations that you have for counseling in our first session. The benefits of counseling may include increased self-awareness, self-confidence, and the achievement of goals. Risks of counseling may include feeling discomfort due to the possibility for change. Working through this changing process may be difficult at times but will be helped by a strong working relationship. I look forward to our work together.

QUALIFICATIONS OF COUNSELOR

I currently provide school counseling and guidance services for students through Plymouth-Canton Community Schools. In addition, I provide individual counseling and counselor supervision in a private practice setting. I received my Master of Education in School Counseling from Loyola University Maryland, a CACREP accredited institution. I have experience counseling students in Kindergarten through the Twelfth grade, including Early College students. I am credentialed as a Licensed Professional Counselor in the State of Michigan, and a National Certified Counselor through the National Board for Certified Counselors.

RIGHTS AND LIMITS OF CONFIDENTIALITY

Most of what is shared during our sessions will remain confidential and can only be disclosed with your written permission. However, some limits to confidentiality do exist. If you suggest harming yourself or others or disclose abuse or neglect of a child or elder, then I am required by law and by ethical standard to report it to the appropriate persons. Also, in some court situations, a judge may order me to disclose confidential information. In any case, only appropriate and necessary information will be provided.

FEE

I do not charge a fee for services provided to students in a school setting. I offer individual counseling services to clients in my private setting at a rate of \$100 per session (sliding scale available based on need). Cash or credit card (including HSA) payments are accepted prior to the start of any individual counseling session. Counseling sessions last one hour, including 45 minutes for therapy and 15 minutes for clerical/billing matters. I look forward to working with you in a collaborative relationship so that your counseling experience will be beneficial to you.
